



Dear UnitedHealthcare Patient,

Unfortunately, after years of serving UnitedHealthcare members, U.S. Anesthesia Partners of Colorado (USAP Colorado) is no longer in network with UnitedHealthcare effective November 1, 2025.

We are disappointed by this development. While we have successfully negotiated contracts with other major health plans, we have not yet reached agreement with United on terms that reflect both rising costs and the value our clinical teams provide.

Understandably, you may be concerned about what this means for your upcoming procedure as USAP Colorado clinicians are part of your care team. We have a long history of caring for all patients, regardless of their insurance status or ability to pay. Accordingly, **USAP Colorado intends to continue treating United members, and we do not expect any disruption to patient service. In addition, you should not receive any surprise medical bills; we intend to invoice you no more than the amount assigned by United for patient responsibility.**
